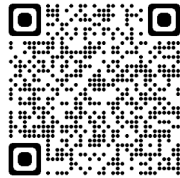


## Equality & Diversity

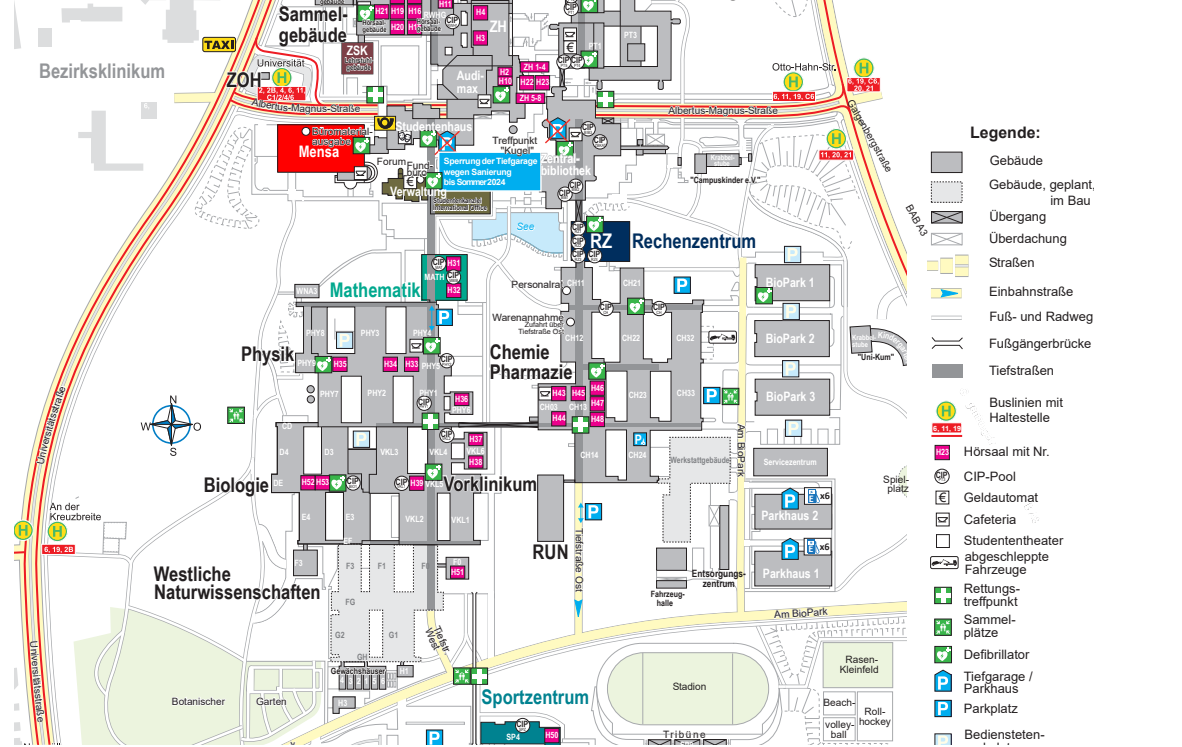

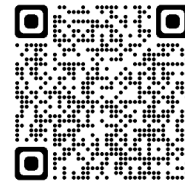
